This time, the questions and experiments in his diary are very natural, very fresh, and organic! He made interesting research on insects, animals, and trees. For instance, why spiders don't stick to their own webs? Do the seahorse fathers breed babies? Why do the leaves turn yellow in the fall? Are rabbits always eating carrots? Philosophant finds interesting but true answers with an amusing and entertaining style. He also noted interesting experiments that children easily can do in their homes.
